He was a loving father, amazing educator and a friend to all he knew. Rest well, my friend, in the arms of Jesus. We had been planning a fundraiser for Lorimer. The need is still there and we are planning to go ahead with the fundraiser to help benefit the family. It will take place January 6, 2018 at Grand Prairie High School, 101 Gopher Blvd., Grand Prairie, TX 75050 from 6:00 PM to 8:30 PM. Lorimer battled stage 4 lung cancer since June 2017. In addition to conventional treatment, he underwent treatment in Mexico which was out of pocket. There will be a silent auction with a mountain dulcimer and a quilt. There is also a concert featuring: The Vanderveer Brothers, David and Annette Lindsey, April and Lloyd Wright, Ron and Linda Bowers, David Moran and Joe Morgan and perhaps a few others.
